Proton Therapy Center in New Jersey Recognized at the 52nd Annual New Good Neighbor Awards

SOMERSET, N.J. (July 23, 2012) – The ProCure Proton Therapy Center in Somerset, N.J. was awarded the "New Good Neighbor Award" by the New Jersey Business & Industry Association and New Jersey Business magazine. One of eight companies to earn the honor at the 52nd Annual Good Neighbor Award Ceremony earlier this month, ProCure was recognized for its contribution to the economic value of the community, as well as for its noteworthy investment in the fight against cancer in New Jersey.

"We are thrilled to be recognized by such prestigious panel members and organizations. The award is an acknowledgement of ProCure's mission to improve the lives of patients with cancer by increasing access to proton therapy," said James Jarrett, president of the center. ProCure broke ground on its New Jersey center in April 2010 and opened its doors in March 2012- reflecting a record-breaking process of only 23 months. The facility's development created 400 local construction jobs, and the center currently employs 100 full-time staff members. At full capacity, the center will be able to treat 1,500 patients each year.

"ProCure's decision to open in Somerset demonstrates the county's determination to diversify its economy," said Mike Kerwin, president of the Somerset County Business Partnership. "ProCure has placed Somerset County in the unique position of being home to the 10th proton therapy center in the nation. Because of this, I was proud to nominate ProCure for this award. Somerset is truly grateful to ProCure's initiation and contribution to the community," Kerwin said.

Cancer is the second-leading cause of death in New Jersey. It's estimated that approximately 49,000 New Jersey residents and more than 107,000 New York residents will be diagnosed with cancer each year. Proton therapy offers an unmatched combination of power and precision. Protons deliver a high dose of cancer stopping energy while emitting up to 80 percent less radiation to healthy tissue and minimizing short- and long-term side effects of standard radiation.

Studies have shown proton therapy to be effective in treating many types of tumors, including brain, central nervous system, gastrointestinal, head and neck, lung and prostate, as well as sarcomas and many pediatric cancers.
